Dear Friends and Supporters,

This past summer was truly amazing! We are so thankful for all of our volunteers and campers that came out and made it so great! God moved in many hearts and minds! Throughout the summer we incurred a number of unexpected and extra expenses that are laid out below in more detail. As always, we strive to offer the best program and the best facilities we can, but also try to maintain everything we have as we move forward. Unfortunately, a number of these expenses piled up and forced us to use our line of credit. It is our goal to have that paid back before the end of the 2024 calendar and we would love your help to do that! Please be in prayer over this. Anything that you choose to give will be such a blessing to our beautiful camp! Thank you in advance for your generosity!

We're raising \$21,000 due to several unexpected costs that have arisen recently:

<u>Pool Repairs:</u> This spring, washout on one side of our pool required major repairs, including hillside rework and rock placement. We still need 3 to 4 more loads of rock to secure the area for winter, costing about \$3,000.

<u>Insurance Costs:</u> We had to switch insurance providers due to our claim history. Our new General Liability insurance alone increased by \$2,000, bringing our total insurance costs to over \$25,000, including auto and workers' compensation. We still lack property coverage.



<u>Bus Repairs:</u> In late July, our bus's radiator blew while on the interstate. After being towed and worked on, the repairs cost over \$6,000.



Additional Expenses: We faced unplanned expenses of over \$5,000 this summer due to supply shortages and other unforeseen needs.

These costs total over \$21,000, impacting our usual budget. We've used our line of credit to cover these expenses and aim to repay it by year-end. Your support would be greatly appreciated during this time.



We trust in God's provision and look forward to seeing how He will guide us through this.
